Trends in Tafsir/Qur'anic Studies in Malaysia in the Postmodern Era Professor Peter G. Riddell

These presentations will begin with a consideration of the features of postmodernism (1950s->) and how it differs from modernism (1860s-1950s). Discussion will then consider evolving Qur'anic exegesis in Malaysia and Indonesia in the postmodern era, taking account of leading scholars and their works and the extent to which this scholarship reflected or responded to emerging postmodernist thinking, either positively or negatively.

Peter G. Riddell is a Professorial Research Associate in History at SOAS University of London and Senior Research Fellow of the Australian College of Theology. His research focuses on Southeast Asian Islamic history and theological texts, with particular references to interpretation of the Qur'an.
